Item No 2: Review of Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for AY 2019-20

Item No 3: A proposal to apply for New UG program- Artificial Intelligence and Machine-Learning for the AY 2021-22

Institute already got approval for the undergraduate course Artificial Intelligence and Data Science. After a lengthy discussion it is concluded to apply for the new program for grant by AICTE.

Item No 4: To review the preparations of the Institute for the forthcoming NBA accreditation

NBA SAR has been submitted to the NBA under Tier-I for three programs namely, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Computer Science Engineering in the month of February 2020. Due to COVID-19 Outbreak the peer team visiting as per the given slots varied and expecting the visit as the imposed lockdown is completely opened. In this regard the members accepted for reviewing the preparations to meet the SAR and suggested for scheduling of departmental visits. All the members approved.

Item No 5: Participation in NIRF-2020

As a Quality initiative the institute has the practice of participation in NIRF every year. The members welcomed the continuation of the practice and suggested for the review of the data before sending to NIRF. The members suggested to identify the points in which the institute lagging for better ranking among the reputed institution. All the members accepted and approved.

Item No 6: To organize induction programme for First Year UG students

Coordinator proposed to conduct induction programme for the first year under graduate students. The time table framing for the induction classes is allotted to the respective departments. All the members accepted the same.

Item No 7: To conduct more faculty development programs/Workshops/STTP's and conferences for the AY 2020-21

Teaching faculty training/ development programs are continuously organized by the departments. It is proposed to apply for the funding to conduct such programs whenever the schemes are released by AICTE. The members suggested to conduct more number of such programs in the upcoming academic year to enhance the knowledge of the faculty members and make them more competitive in the technological field.
